

TELL ICE TO KEEP JEAN MONTREVIL WITH HIS FAMILY!

National immigrant rights leader detained New Year's Eve and his deportation is imminent.



CAN CONTACT THE PEOPLE WHO HAVE THE POWER TO STOP THIS TODAY:

→Using Jean's full name and A#40135784, express your distress that this community leader and father of 4 US citizen children was detained (one day before New Year's Eve!).

→Tell Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) you want to see this family kept together

→Use the talking points below:

-ICE has the power to stop Jean's deportation and Jean has the deep support of the community!

-Jean's application for deferred action was not adequately considered and for over 1 year Jean and his supporters have been asking for a meeting to discuss his case and never gotten one

-Jean is a long time Legal Permanent Resident, community leader and activist who has 4 US citizen kids and US citizen wife

- Jean's youngest son Jahsiah has severe asthma and is legally disabled and Jean is his primary caretaker

-Jean is not a 'serious violent offender'; he had a criminal conviction 20 years ago for which he served his time

-Temporary Protected Status (TPS) for Haitians is under serious consideration by the Obama Administration and this relief could help Jean
