*An initiative of the National Network for Immigrant and Refugee Rights*

HURRICANE/El Huracán: **Human Rights Immigrant Community Action Network** is part of a nationwide campaign launched by NNIRR to track, document, and take action against human rights violations perpetrated against immigrant and refugee communities.

**HURRICANE** brings together three areas of long-term work for redress of violations and to uphold the human rights of all people, regardless of their immigration status.

- **TAKE ACTION! Join the Urgent Response Network:** Through community-based solidarity and an urgent response network, HURRICANE is bringing together community groups, immigrant rights advocates and organizers to demand redress and accountability in cases of human rights violations, including raids, police abuse and exploitation in the workplace and community.
- **SPEAK OUT! Denounce, Resist Abuses through the 100 Stories Project:** Through the collection of “100 Stories” we will document first-hand accounts of abuses and rights violations experienced by our communities to highlight the types of injustices sanctioned under the current immigration ‘enforcement’ regime. We will establish the case for the types of reforms needed as we lift up our voices for justice!
